



SH 99 Grand Parkway Update

Good Afternoon,

The Grand Parkway Infrastructure team has made great progress over the past few months and anticipates a very busy summer season. We understand that the past few months have been challenging for many due to COVID-19, and we hope that you and your loved ones stay safe. Our safety team has been working diligently to ensure that all workers stay safe on our construction sites during this global health crisis. Below you will find construction updates on segments H, I-1, and I-2 of the Grand Parkway.

Segment H Update

Major activities within Segment H include:

- Over the next few months crews will continue to work on the bridge that will travel over IH 69/US 90. This work will require lane reductions and closures. In April, crews set all bridge beams over the main lanes and frontage roads. **(photo)**
- The construction of the bridge over Plum Grove Road in New Caney is underway.
- Crews continue to perform bridge work over Loop 494 near Community Drive.
- Bridge work at Peach Creek continues with the installation of columns and caps. **(photo)**
- The team in New Caney is progressing with the construction of the new frontage roads along FM 1485. Over the coming weeks, a traffic switch will be implemented to allow for the crews to construct the new SH 99 main lanes.
- Scott Gardner Road at FM 1485 is tentatively scheduled to be closed until June 2021. This closure is needed to ensure that the traveling public is safe while the team builds main lanes and frontage roads in the area.



Segment I-1 Update

Major activities within Segment I-1 include:

- Over the past few months, crews have mobilized to FM 1960 to construct the new SH 99 bridge. Wall panels on the south side of the roadway have been erected. Flagging operations in the area will continue for the foreseeable future. **(photo)**
- Within the next several weeks, the team will be implementing a

traffic modification to FM 1960 in order for the team to perform critical activities associated with the new bridge that will travel over the roadway. More details will be available over the coming weeks.

- Land clearing, grading, and wall panels have begun bridge that will travel on US 90. The construction of this large bridge will require periodic lane closures.
- While most of the work in this segment may not be seen by the general public, the team in Dayton continues to make great progress on the construction of frontage roads, main lanes, and bridges.



Segment I-2 Update

Major activities within Segment I-2 include:

- Construction of the bridge that will travel over IH 10 continues. **Pictured on the right**, crews set deck panels on the bridge just south of IH 10. The team is tentatively scheduled to erect the bridge beams over IH 10 in August. This operation will require travel impacts to the frontage roads and main lanes.
- Frontage road construction on Business 146 in Baytown continues, with the anticipation that later this summer, traffic in the area will be switched to the newly constructed frontage roads while crews begin construction of the SH 99 main lanes. **(photo)**
- Crews have mobilized to SH 146 in Mont Belvieu to begin drill shafts for the new SH 99 bridge that will travel over SH 146. During the construction of this bridge, motorists should expect lane closures in the area.
- Next month, crews will implement traffic modifications on Business 146 near Goose Lake in Baytown to allow for crews to perform work on the new main lanes and widen the existing bridges.
