Closure of US 90 Eastbound/Westbound Travel Lanes

March 13, 2021 (8PM – 5AM)

DAYTON, Texas – The Grand Parkway Infrastructure team is excited to announce that crews are scheduled to engage in another critical milestone; the construction of the new SH 99 bridge that will travel over US 90. Bridge beam operations over all US 90 main lanes will take place on Saturday, March 13 between the hours of 8PM and 5AM. The closure of US 90 will occur between FM 1413 and SH 146. Motorists traveling in the area during the operation will be detoured to FM 1413 and SH146. In the coming weeks following the bridge beam sets, the construction of this new bridge will be performed in several stages as crews will need to set deck panels, pour the concrete roadway, and other miscellaneous activities requiring individual lane closures.

This work is part of the next stages of construction on the 184-mile Grand Parkway highway project. Work is currently underway on Segments H, I-1 & I-2, representing a 52.8-mile corridor spanning Chambers, Harris, Liberty and Montgomery counties, northeast of Houston, Texas. Construction of new lanes and the modernization of the existing tolling infrastructure will increase capacity and improve mobility. These segments of the Grand Parkway loop are expected to open Spring 2022.
